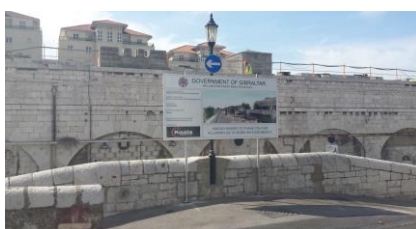
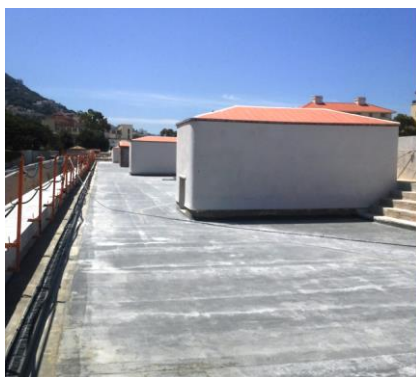
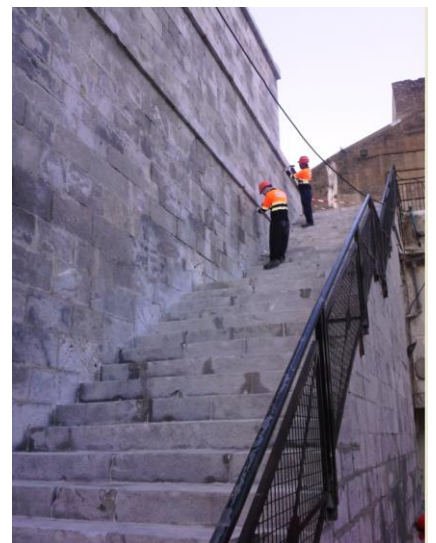
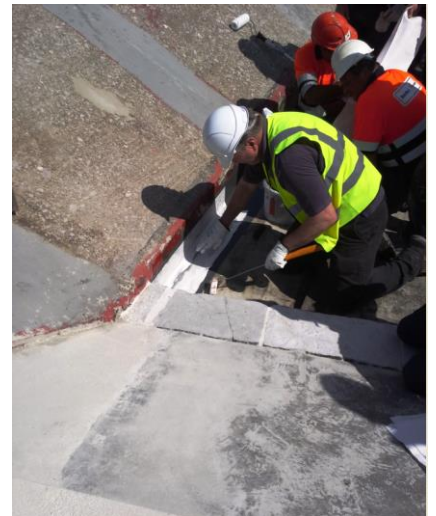
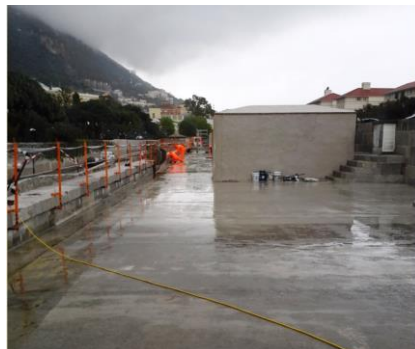
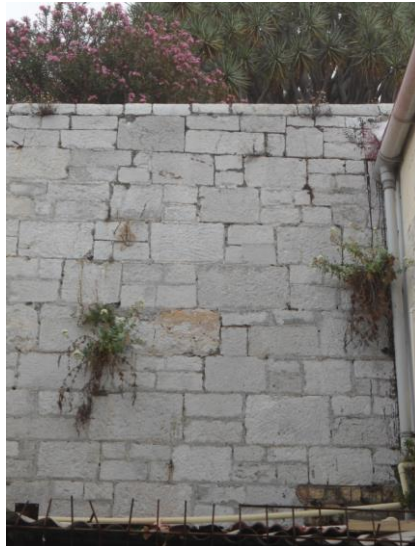
Wellington Front (1850) is a long stretch of curtain wall that forms part of the Line Wall Curtain. It stands on the site of the old city wall built during the Moorish period and subsequently modified by the Spanish and British.

Works include:

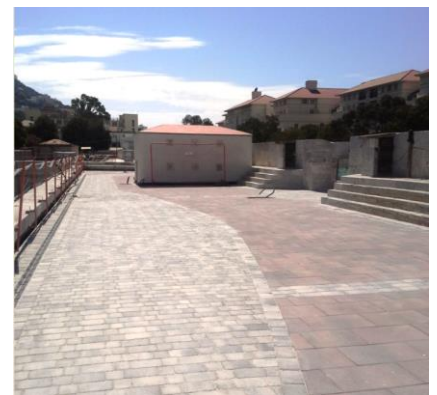
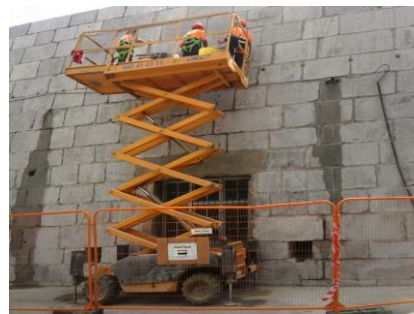
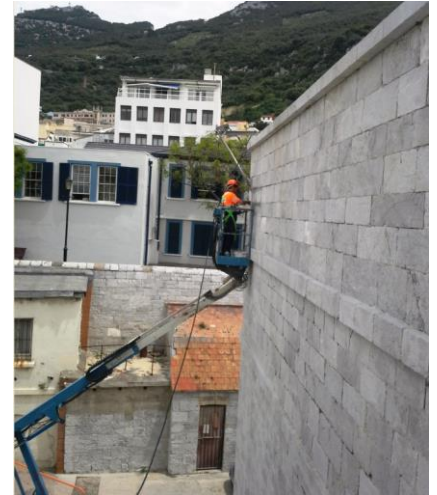
- Demolition of several buildings.
- Waterproofing of the roof slab to the entire complex.
- New infrastructure to the internal courtyard.
- Paving of all the areas.
